

# POQUITO MOSCATO

Varietal: Moscatel de Alejandria  
Vintage: NV  
D.O.: Valencia

A lightly sparkling, fruity style white wine, Poquito Moscato is small in size, but big on flavor. A little bottle, perfect served chilled for any celebration as a fruity alternative to dry sparkling wines.

## TASTING NOTES

Color: Pale straw  
Nose: Intense and enticing aromas of ripe peach and grapes with delicate floral notes  
Palate: Sweet with fresh fruit and honeyed flavors  
Finish: Pleasing and sweet  
Food Match: As an aperitif or with desserts, especially a fruit tart or a sorbet. Also matches up surprisingly well to a cheese course.

## VINIFICATION

Poquito Moscato is made from Moscatel de Alejandria grapes which have been grown for centuries in the Valencia region of Spain near the Mediterranean Sea. This extremely aromatic white varietal needs steady warm temperatures to express its huge potential.

The grapes are carefully selected, crushed and very gently macerated in cold temperatures in order to extract aroma and color. Fermentation in tanks is stopped at the desired stage by reducing the temperature, leaving a fruity, light 5% alcohol wine.
