*Campo de Borja's continental climate comes with a unique twist, the "cierzo" wind that blows cold, dry air down from the northwest; summers are very hot and winters are cold. The area consists mainly of high plateaus and hills and the DO is nicknamed "Empire of Garnacha" for its most famous grape.*

### WINEMAKING & VINEYARDS

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WINEMAKER: NORREL ROBERTSON  
WINERY: BODEGAS AINZÓN

The perfectly ripe Garnacha grapes were grown on clay and limestone soils and were harvested in October after a long, hot summer. After gentle pressing the juice is left on the skins for few hours to give the wine its trademark pink blush. The alcoholic fermentation (14-16°C) takes place in stainless steel tanks.

### TASTING NOTES

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Bold, complex wine with rich raspberry hues; there is plenty of wild strawberry and raspberry fruit on the nose. The palate is deliciously dry with intense strawberry and floral aromas with a creamy mouthfeel and long finish.

### FOOD MATCH

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Great with tapas, barbequed foods, salads, seafood and white meats.
