ROSÉ 2024 AOC BORDEAUX – FRANCE

Bordeaux vineyards are cooled by Atlantic Ocean breezes and produce elegant and dry pale pink Rosé wines like this. Atlantique is a Cabernet Franc led blend that is more than a match for many more expensive options from Provence.

The vineyards are situated in the heart of the Bordeaux, close to Gironde department.

Top quality vineyards grow on a mixture of limestone, clay, and porous silt soils that supply the fabulous Cabernet Franc, Malbec and Merlot grapes harvested at the beginning of September. After gentle pressing and careful racking, the alcoholic fermentation is started at a low temperature (17°C) and lasts 12 days.

TASTING NOTES

Pale pink, yet a vibrant food friendly Rosé in the classic French style. There is plenty of wild strawberry and raspberry fruit on the nose. The palate is deliciously fresh, elegant, and soft with crisp acidity. Generous fruit flavors, but delightfully dry.

FOOD MATCH

Perfect fresh from the chiller, as an aperitif or with salads, white meats cooked on the grill and even lightly spiced Asian dishes.
