WINEMAKING & VINEYARDS

WINEMAKER: SEBASTIÉN BAPTISTE
WINERY: TERRE DE VIGNERONS

The vineyards for this wine are cultivated on clay-limestone soils and were planted around 25 years ago. Harvesting began in early September in dry and sunny conditions. The winemaking is traditional with fermentation in concrete and stainless steel tanks for 7 days at a maximum temperature of 28C, followed by malolactic fermentation in stainless steel vats.

TASTING NOTES

Clear and bright deep ruby red color with subtle violet highlights. The nose is expressive and fruity with notes of black cherry, blackcurrant and a hint of sweet spice. The mouth is supple and smooth with soft tannins and a fruity, slightly peppery finish.

FOOD MATCH

This smooth, easy-drinking French red can be enjoyed with vegetable dishes, roast lamb and hard cheeses. Vegan Friendly.
